Australian development cooperation supports Niue to improve its economic prosperity.

Strategic direction

Australia supports development activities in Niue in partnership with New Zealand. Australia's investment responds to Niue's priorities and focuses on **education**, **waste management**, **economic development** (SDG 8) and **economic resilience, strengthening governance institutions** (SDG 16), **health** (SDG 3) and **social cohesion**. Activities will also support Niue's recovery from the economic impacts of COVID-19, particularly in the tourism sector, and will help build an educated workforce ready to contribute to **economic growth** (SDG 4). Strengthening Niue's **waste management infrastructure** (SDG 9) will create healthier environments.

Program highlights

- Four students were accepted into the 2020 **Australia Awards Pacific Scholarship** intake and are working towards qualifications in engineering and construction.
- Implementation work has commenced on a **waste management project**, which will help Niue sort and divert recyclable materials away from landfill and manage hazardous waste.

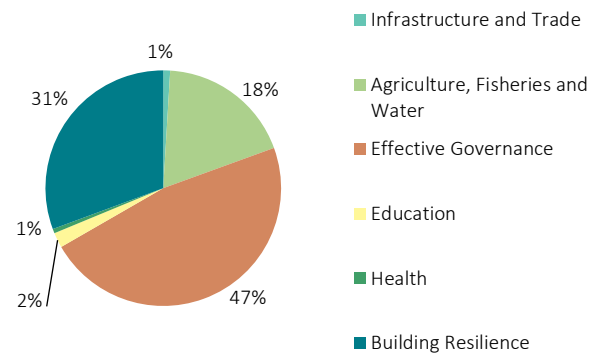
